On Simhat Torah the **Hattan Torah** (Bridegroom of the Torah) is honored with the Aliyah that completes the cycle of the Torah reading for the year. The **Hattan B'reishit** is then honored with the Aliyah which begins the Book of Genesis. This is the only time during the year when pre-Bar and Bat Mitzvah children – **Kol Hane'arim** (All of the Children) are called to the Torah for an Aliyah. An adult is specially honored to lead them. The **Ba'alat Maftir** chants the Haftarah.
