Pursuing Justice and Living with Injustice: A Firsthand Account

Chester Holman III spent 28 years in prison for a crime he did not commit. When he was exonerated in July, the judge and district attorney apologized for the miscarriages of justice that led to his incarceration. What does it take to survive in prison and live with injustice for so long? What is it like to experience freedom and try to start life anew?

Rabbi Dr. Andrea Weiss, the Jack, Joseph and Morton Mandel Provost of HUC-JIR, will moderate a conversation between Chester and his attorney, Alan Tauber exploring the themes of forgiveness, justice, and renewal that are so central to the High Holy Days.
