Vav-Zayin (Middle School) Program

Our sixth and seventh grade middle school students will meet each **Tuesday, from 4-6 PM**. They will have units in Current Events, Antisemitism, Holocaust, Israel, Jewish Ethics, Heroes, Jewish ritual and Torah trope.

Sixth graders and a parent will also meet on **10 Sunday mornings** over the course of the year, which will include 9 + Me with Hazzan Vogel, a Tallit and Tefillin Club prayer experience, and a trip or special program each session. (Some trips may be all day).

Seventh graders will meet on **7 Sundays through the year** for special projects, such as a trip to New York, an Abiri Arts program, and an Israel-themed activity. Some of these will bring them together with other seventh graders from the Lower Merion area synagogues, and three of these will be held with LMAHH to begin to introduce them to our collaborative Hebrew High program run by Norman Einhorn and his team.

There will also be weekly online Hebrew groups for **40 minutes each, three Friday night and three Shabbat morning experiences** that include a service, meal or Kiddush, and an activity.
