This year there are two simple ways you can help nourish families in need:

Purchase **grocery store gift cards** to be distributed directly to clients of the Mitzvah Food Program so they can purchase items they need from their local grocery store – ShopRite, Acme and Giant – as these are the stores most easily accessible to our clients. Gift card values up to \$50 are the most helpful. The cards can be dropped off at Har Zion’s receptionist desk.
