Israeli startup BrightWay Vision is working to solve this problem. The company's new "BrightEye" technology provides an "enlightening" experience, both literally and figuratively. The screen on the car's dashboard provides a clear, panoramic view of the road, similar to that achieved when turning on one's bright beams, without actually doing so. In addition, the headlights of the cars coming in the opposite direction appear as small dots, with none of the blinding glare.
