INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISCALL DEAS Protecting and Saving Lives through Real-Time Monitoring

It's a common story: Mrs. Smith is aging, and ailing, perhaps in danger of falling on a regular basis. Her heart is weak, and cardiac problems are a constant concern. Yet, Mrs. Smith refuses to wear an Emergency Alert bracelet, as it offends her feeling of independence. And, she certainly isn't going to wear a heart monitor in bed.

Enter EarlySense, an Israeli developed system which monitors patients who need continuous tracking, without wires. The system uses sensors embedded into a mattress or chair cushion to monitor heartbeat, respiration rate, and movement.


