INNOVATION UPDATE FROM Putting Drug Development on Fast Track

The cost of developing a new pharmaceutical drug, from the research and development stage to market approval, runs at about \$2.6 billion, according to a 2014 report published by the Tufts Center for the Study of Drug Development (CSDD) cited by the Scientific American. It also takes between 10 to 15 years. Israeli scientists say they have developed a revolutionary smart method to discover and develop new drugs, based on artificial intelligence and machine learning that will dramatically shorten preparation time and reduce costs.

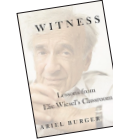

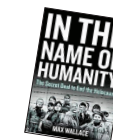

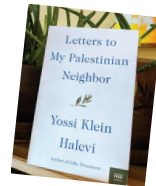
