INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Creating Water-based Fuel for Electric Vehicles

Israeli-Australian startup Electriq~Global says it has found a way to use water to power electric vehicles. The company said its water-based recyclable fuel is “highly efficient, safe” and clean and can be used to power electric vehicles with zero emissions.

The company, formerly known as Terragenic, was presenting its technology as part of the EcoMotion 2018 “Smart Mobility Summit” taking place in Tel Aviv. The technology, which the company calls “revolutionary,” extracts hydrogen from the fuel, which is then utilized to create electricity to power the vehicle.

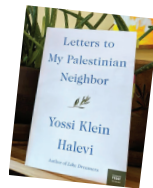
