INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS An Innovative Way to Diagnose and Monitor ADHD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder)

Worldwide, between 5% and 7% percent of people under the age of 18 have ADHD, according to the ADHD Institute. It affects up to one in 20 American children, more often boys than girls, and often continues into adulthood.

The Israeli company, NeuroTechnology Solutions, developed an Internet-based software technology that helps clinicians better diagnose and monitor attention problems. The system, Moxo Analytics, has different versions for children and adults and delivers scores on a range of developmental, cognitive and behavioral components of ADHD making it easier to decide how to help the person with ADHD.
