What does Meskele Cristos in Ethiopia, Nepal, Minjingu in north Tanzania, Syria, Sri Lanka (and other countries) have in common... Israel offering their water technology skill and knowledge. Drew Bergman is a senior at Temple University. While Drew is a successful full-time student with a bright future ahead, this was not always the case. Drew's early teenage years were filled with a severe case of depression. For a brief time, he was able to hide his depression and continue to perform as an outstanding athlete and solid student. However, in his sophomore year of high school Drew experienced a turning point in his recovery when he attempted suicide for the second time.

Drew is a 2014 recipient of the Need In Deed Community Partner Award. He was a presenter at the national SADD conference and was one of the keynote speakers at the Pennsylvania State PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) Conference where he presented to 1,000 educators and school counselors.

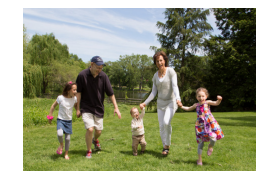
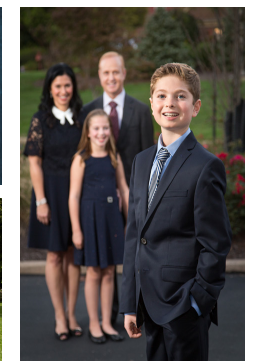
