For most people, paying taxes and taking the car in for repairs is on their list of "things they hate to do but have to do." When a car has a problem, drivers ready themselves to do battle with their mechanics, bargaining to get the best repair deal and wondering if they will get ripped off. Now there's an app and a device that promises to give drivers all the data they need about what is wrong (and right) with their vehicles. 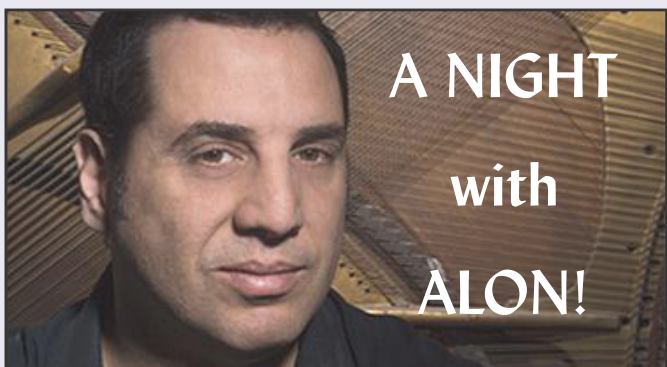

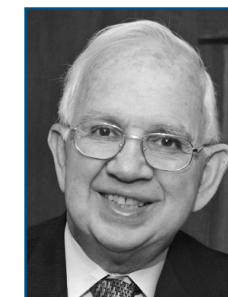

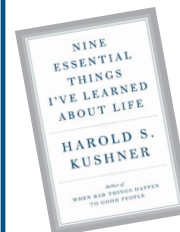
