People are slowly coming to understand that social media can be destructive to job prospects, relationships, and even bank accounts. For example, employers look at Facebook pages of employees, looking for “inappropriate behavior”. In addition, there have been many cases of victims who have been shamed – especially teens – who have attempted to hurt themselves after compromising videos and photos of them were posted on social media.

Helping to prevent shaming, was a major motivation for the development of the app, said the co-CEOs and developers of the SessMe app. “Polls show that in 90% of cases, individuals between 13 and 21 would want to take back a photo or video that was hurtful to others.
