## The Madregot Program of The Jane Fishman Grinberg Religious School

The Hebrew translation of **Madregot** means “steps” and we are proud that we can help our children take steps towards the goal of living a Jewish life in our community.

- Children who are differently enabled are welcomed into a nurturing Jewish learning environment.
- Each child is encouraged to maximize his or her learning potential, and is instilled with a life-long love of Judaism.
- While some children learn prayers, others may be able to identify Jewish symbols and others may use an assistive device to communicate.
- Creative teaching techniques allow the students to enjoy their instruction through the use of art and music.
- Dedicated aides are assigned as needed.
- Resource teachers working with inclusive small groups throughout the grades.
- **Madregot** provides a warm and welcoming path leading the child to become a Bar or Bat Mitzvah.
- Beyond that, each child is encouraged to study for Confirmation and, most importantly, become an active member of the Jewish community.



### How Can I Participate?
