

Why Is It So Hard to Be Good?



An introduction to Mussar, its history and its contemporary practice Mussar is a Jewish ethical, educational and cultural approach to Jewish living that developed in 19th century Lithuania. The Hebrew term Musar, is from the book of Proverbs 1:2 meaning moral conduct, instruction or discipline. The term was used by the Musar movement to refer to efforts to further ethical and spiritual discipline.
