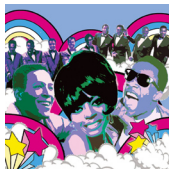

What is GWC2S?

GWC2S is an initiative that uses the power of Shabbat meals to strengthen our synagogue's sense of kehillah or community. Participants can host Shabbat dinner (on Fridays) or Shabbat lunch (on Saturdays) in their own homes or be guests at someone else's home.

How does it work?

You decide whether you want to be a host or a guest. If you are hosting, you can invite families you know or request to host families you have not met. You decide whether it's Friday night dinner or Saturday lunch. As a host, you choose the menu and the time. We provide a Shabbat kit that includes challah, wine, candlesticks, and a card with all of the Shabbat blessings.



Beginning the morning of Thursday, February 19, Shabbat kits will be available for pick up in the Groom's Room at Har Zion.
