INNOVATION UPDATE FROM 

Israeli Technology Helps Speech Impaired to Communicate in Their Own Voice
Wearable Device Slows Brain Tumor Growth

Patients can wear Novocure's TTFIELDS device while doing normal activities. A novel wearable device, already used on nearly 2000 patients to slow the growth of cancerous glioblastoma brain tumors using electrical fields, is now being tested to judge its effectiveness against other types of solid tumors. The multi-national company Novocure, is working hard to develop further applications for its Tumor Treating Fields (TTFIELDS) technology, originally developed by Dr. Yoram Palti, now a retired professor from the world renowned Technion Institute in Israel. TTFIELDS therapy is delivered via a non-invasive electrode device attached to the patient's scalp.
