INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS A Phone That Sniffs Out Cancer

Cancer cells emit a different “odor” than normal breath. The Na-Nose technology developed in Israel “smells” your breath to determine if the disease exists. No-Nose has been proven in numerous international clinical trials to differentiate between different types and classifications of cancer with up to 95 percent accuracy.

The Sniff-Phone would link the same technology to a smartphone to provide non-invasive, fast and cheap disease detection. According to the technology's developer, Dr. Hassom Haick, “it will enable immediate and early diagnosis that is both accurate and non-invasive.
