Spam – The Annoying 'Zombie Armies Of The Internet' May Have Met Their Match

According to experts, a team from Israeli's Ben Gurion University, working with the communications giant Deutsche Telekom, may have found a way to shut down one of the scourges of the Internet – botnets – the unlawful and secretive networks that as many as a half a billion computers have fallen prey to world-wide.

Using data and analytical intelligence technology, the researchers figured out how to track a botnet to its controller – and the location of the server that is managing illicit activity costing the world economy \$100 billion a year.
