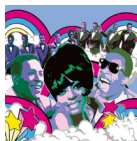

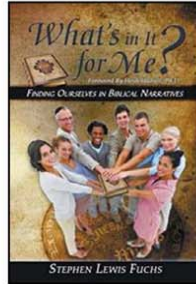

Approximately 1.5% of the world's population suffers from a speech impediment, and is challenged by this vital and basic human activity.
