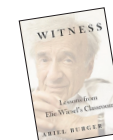

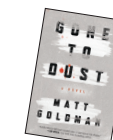

***Honor Your Father and Your Mother: Caring for Sick or Elderly Parents***

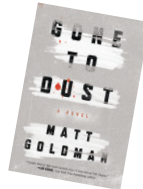
