A Hebrew Immersion Program

Overview

Sha'ar Philadelphia campers enjoy all the fun of Ramah Day Camp while participating in a unique, intensive Hebrew language program. All aspects of the camp day are conducted in Hebrew, giving children an opportunity to gain proficiency as they participate in the full schedule of activities — swim, sports, arts and crafts, and more.

Campers learn to understand and speak Hebrew naturally, by listening to and speaking with their counselors and peers. Our counselors hail from Israel and the United States, and have fluency in Hebrew, as well as a strong understanding of child development. They receive specialized training before and during camp.

Sha'ar is embedded in our Shorashim, Cochavim, Nitzanim, Alonim and Solelim edot (Pre-K to 3rd grade divisions). No knowledge of Hebrew is required.

Your children will come home proud of their new language skills, and with more confidence in themselves!
