# INNOVATION UPDATE FROM *ISF BLUEBS* Breakthrough in Non-invasive Prostate Cancer Test

Israeli scientists at Kaplan Medical Center have reported a breakthrough of successfully detecting prostate cancer cells with high sensitivity using Micromedic Technologies' CellDetect noninvasive diagnostic test, developed at Kaplan over the past two years. The news comes less than a week after British actor and comedian Stephen Fry revealed he is being treated for prostate cancer, which afflicts nearly one adult male in nine sometime during his lifetime. Among many other celebrities who have battled prostate cancer are Robert De Niro, Mandy Patinkin, Harry Belafonte and Frank Zappa. Prostate cancer is the second most common cancer (after skin cancer) among men worldwide and is the third-leading cause of death in men worldwide. The disease is very treatable if found early, and in some cases the cancer grows very slowly and does not need treatment.
