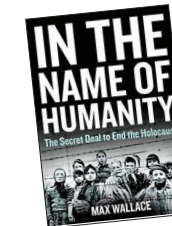

The Guide to the Perplexed Seder Leader – How to Customize the Haggadah

The Rabbis expected much of the conductor of a seder – to be a master of ceremonies, a parent educator and a symposium/talk show moderator. The haggadah can be confusing and boring when recited, but it can be empowering when treated as a how-to manual and when one learns how to skip judiciously and supplement for variety and depth. For example, using contemporary artwork, we can engage participants in the politics and psychology of the four sons and daughters.
