Through its innovative development and use of 11 different algorithms, Zebra Medical can identify visual symptoms for diseases such as breast cancer, osteoporosis, fatty liver, and conditions such as vertebral fractures, aneurysms, and brain bleeds.

The company will begin deploying its revolutionary medical imaging AI solutions in one of Israel's largest hospitals, Tel Aviv's Ichilov, as well as with Clalit Health Services and Maccabi Healthcare Services – Israel's largest and second-largest HMO, respectively. The three medical entities manage some 90 percent of patients in Israel, the company said.
