### INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS An App That Can Be a Life Saver in Allergy Emergencies

Israeli researchers have developed a Smartphone app that could help save the lives of people with severe allergic reactions, like anaphylactic shock, and those suffering from opioid overdoses, which have led to the deaths of over 40,000 Americans in 2016 alone according to US authorities. In Israel, researchers from Bar-Ilan University partnered with the country's national emergency medical service Magen David Adom to develop "EPIMADA," a Smartphone app said to be the first social network for chronic patients – in this case, those suffering from allergic reactions – who can facilitate the sharing and delivery of emergency medication like EpiPens. Allergic reactions to food, medications, flora, and fauna can range from mild – coughing, sneezing, watery eyes – to severe, where sufferers can go into anaphylactic shock, a state brought on by allergen which in extreme cases can lead to death.

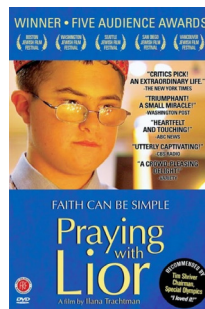
