### **INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Making Water From Air To Keep Kids Healthy**

Max Simonovsky's two-and-a-half-year-old son was well trained in routine hand washing. But one day when the water in his neighborhood was shut off for repairs, the boy reasoned that if water wasn't available, he therefore had no need to wash his hands after playing outside. The Israeli dad was fascinated by his toddler's way of thinking and discussed it with friends. They realized that the same line of logic may apply to millions of children in areas of the world that lack running water or electricity.

Further investigation revealed that two leading causes of death in young children in the developing world are diarrhea and respiratory infections. UNICEF and the World Health Organization say both could be significantly reduced by hygiene practices such as hand washing.

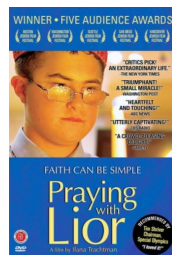
