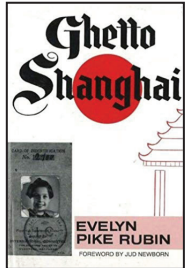

INNOVATION UPDATE FROM **ISRAEL IDEAS**

Treating Burns with a Second Skin

Some 180,000 deaths occur each year worldwide because of burn wounds, the World Health Organization (WHO) estimates. In Israel, there were around 3,300 burn wound deaths in 2017, with 84 percent of accidents occurring in the domestic environment, according to the Health Ministry. Israeli startup Nanomedic Technologies Ltd. has developed a medical device that it says can dress burns and other wounds with nano materials that mimic human tissue and peel off once the skin below is regenerated.

He has published many articles and books, especially one book called – On Heaven and Earth – which he wrote with the Archbishop of Buenos Aires Cardinal Bergoglio, who is currently Pope Francis. He is currently University Professor at Saint Joseph’s University, working closely with its Institute for Jewish-Catholic Relations.

Part 2: History of Jewish Philadelphia: Jewish Neighborhoods in Philadelphia

In these four weeks we trace the patterns of migration of the children of Jewish immigrants as they moved out of South Philadelphia toward Strawberry Mansion, West Philly, Wynnefield, and Logan. Then we will delve into the “Third Settlement” – neighborhoods close to the edge of the city that were built up after the second World War, and more. We’ll look at the evolution of these communities, and discuss the new realities of outer ring suburbanization, resettlement of the city, and the impact of immigration from the former Soviet Union, the resurgence of Orthodox Judaism, and Jewish rise to prominence in politics and philanthropy.
