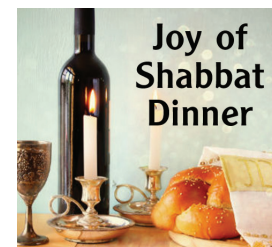

### **INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS A Walking Device Focusing On Stroke Victims**

ReWalk Robotics Ltd., the Israeli developer of a robotic exoskeleton system that helps the paralyzed to walk, has started a clinical study of a new product that will aid the rehabilitation of people who have suffered a stroke. The company said that a first study participant began using a new "soft exo-suit system," the ReStore, which is meant to rehabilitate individuals with lower limb disability due to stroke. The patient was at the Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts, where the study is being led by a team of researchers from the Boston University College of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences: Sargent College.

The study seeks to enroll 40 participants at five of the top rehabilitation hospitals in the US, the company said. "Launching the clinical study is a crucial step forward in the effort to offer the ReStore as a commercial product for the rehabilitation of stroke survivors worldwide," said ReWalk CEO Larry Jasinski. Spaulding is a renowned rehabilitation facility, he said, and the trial will help patients access this cutting edge technology.
