INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS **Treating Alzheimer's, MS, Crohn's and More**

Could one drug effectively treat incurable inflammatory diseases such as Crohn's disease, ulcerative
colitis, rheumatoid arthritis and multiple sclerosis, as well as neurodegenerative maladies such
as Alzheimer's disease?

Yes, says Professor David Naor of the Hebrew University Hadassah Medical School. All these
diseases, he explains, are associated with pathological amyloid proteins that could be neutralized
by the 5-mer peptide Naor has spent the last 10 years researching and developing with the
support of the university's Yissum technology-transfer company, the Israeli government, and
Spherium Biomed of Spain.

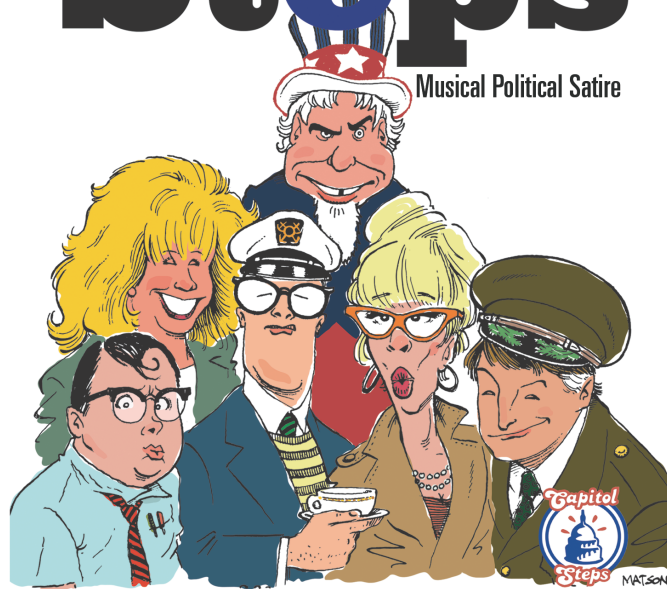
