Debby Einatan is an Israeli mom who refused to accept that her son Rotem would be unable to walk and play and participate in activities like other "normal" children. Her love for her child, her drive to help, and her genius innovation are not just helping Rotem to walk, but also thousands of disabled kids around the world. "Upsee," the harness Debby invented allows handicapped children around the world, to walk in tandem with their parents. The benefits of this device are not only physical, but also emotional. The Upsee harness is fastened on to the guiding adult at the waist, enabling them to pull the child up to a standing position using another harness attached to the child's shoulders and legs. Then, the child and adult fasten the shoe bindings which help the two take steps together.
