## INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Imagine A Surgery-Free Operating Room

In March, participants in the 16th International Symposium on Therapeutic Ultrasound saw a live-streamed medical procedure to cure a woman's essential tremor without incisions or anesthesia. Neurology and radiology experts at Rambam Health Care Campus used the Exablate Neuro system developed in Israel by Insightec. Guided by magnetic resonance (MR) imaging, they focused multiple ultrasonic beams of acoustic energy to heat and destroy target cells in the patient's thalamus. The conference attendees saw the 65-year-old baker – who had suffered tremors for a decade despite medication – walk out of the three-hour procedure, sit down and slice a celebratory cake to share with the neurology team. "I wanted to cry, because I could not remember when I was able to drink a glass of water, and for the first time in over 10 years, I can finally return to serving people in my bakery," she said.
