

"Upsee," the harness Debby invented allows handicapped children around the world, to walk in tandem with their parents. The

The Upsee harness is fastened on to the guiding adult at the waist, enabling them to pull the child up to a standing position using another harness attached to the child's shoulders and legs. Then, the child and adult fasten the shoe bindings which help the two take steps together.
