Israel Rushes Aid to Earthquake Victims in Nepal

Each week, we write about an exciting new innovation from Israel that is positively impacting people's lives. There are plenty of them. Israeli technology is saving, protecting and enhancing lives across the globe. This week, however we are focusing not on a new technological breakthrough, but on the spirit of international goodwill that Israel embodies.

In the wake of the devastating earthquake in Nepal just three days ago, Israel is rapidly deploying personnel to help the victims. On April 27, an IDF plane carrying 90 rescue workers and supplies lifted off from Ben Gurion Airport, headed for the Nepalese capital of Kathmandu.
