# INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISCAEL DEAS

### A Whole New World for the Visually Impaired

Amnon Shashua and Ziv Aviram, the founders of Mobileye, one of Israel's biggest companies acquired by Intel for its groundbreaking vision-based driver-assistance system, have also been advancing another vision-based assistive product, which Aviram told Reuters "has the potential to be even bigger."

It's a game-changer for the visually-impaired who want to be able to freely move about with everyday tasks without calling attention to themselves, says OrCam Director of Media and Communications Rafi Fischer. The Jerusalembased company is "returning independence to the user," said Fischer. "This is the world's most advanced artificial vision device for people who are blind, partially sighted and has reading difficulties," he adds.
