INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS

A Hands-free Cursor Controller For People With Upper-Limb Limitations

Aryeh Katz, son of American-Canadian émigré parents, entered the Israel Defense Forces in 2002. His foot injury led him and his wife to invent Crescent by 6Degrees, a hands-free cursor controller for any Bluetooth-enabled device, guided by the user's personal set of arm motions. This Israeli paratrooper's serious injury left him with complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS), a chronic condition caused by nerve damage to a limb. Going through the grueling treatment and healing process gave Katz and his then girlfriend, Miri Berger, an appreciation for the hardships of disabled soldiers. They hoped one day to do something about that.
