How Can You Mend A Broken Heart?

Hearts can be broken in so many ways, and aren't easy to fix. Physical hearts containing four chambers — left and right atriums on the top; left and right ventricles on the bottom – working together to circulate blood through our bodies. The left atrium receives oxygenated blood returning from the lungs and pumps it into the left ventricle through the mitral valve. From there, the blood is ready to go on its bodily voyage.

Heart failure, affecting as many as 26 million adults worldwide, occurs gradually as the heart muscle weakens and struggles to do its job. The more common left-sided heart failure happens when the left ventricle doesn't pump efficiently. Blood backs up into the lungs, causing shortness of breath and fluid buildup.
