INNOVATION UPDATE FROM  Keeping Milk Fresh Without Electricity

For more than 1.5 billion people without adequate access to electricity, keeping milk fresh is an impossible battle. But Israeli researchers have found that short-pulsed electric fields can be used to kill milk-contaminating bacteria, thus making storing milk outside the refrigerator possible. Through a process called electroporation, bacterial cell membranes are selectively damaged. According to Tel Aviv University's lead investigator Dr. Alexander Golberg, applying this process intermittently prevents bacteria proliferation in stored milk, potentially increasing its shelf life.
