If you suffer from pollen allergies or are concerned about "indoor pollution" from sources such as cleaning materials, furniture glue and mold, you might have considered buying an air purifier. And if you're a safety-concerned home owner, you probably already have a few smoke and carbon monoxide alarms installed. Israeli startup Aura Air asks: Why buy two devices when you could have it all-in-one? The Tel Aviv-based company launched a crowd-funding campaign earlier this year to build its indoor air-quality detector and air purifier combo. The goal was a modest \$15,000, but backers pledged close to \$300,000. That's on top of the \$1.5 million the company received from private angel investors when it launched in 2017.
