You've just run out of toothpaste and you've got a big date tonight and there's no time to drive to the store. You're starving for sushi but your favorite restaurant says it will be at least an hour to get take-out to your door. No worries. Just send in the drones. Delivery by small pilot-less aircraft from the store to your door is coming soon. Amazon is experimenting with it in the United States and Britain right now. Postal services in Europe are running tests, too. Civil aviation authorities in Africa are amending their regulations to make flying over urban environments safe. The missing piece: automating the entire system so that each drone doesn't need to be manually operated without knowledge of what else is in the sky.
