### INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS

**Free App for Detecting Skin Cancer**

Approximately 420 million people worldwide have a high risk of getting melanoma, the most deadly form of skin cancer, particularly those with fair skin. Annual treatment expenditures for melanoma in the U.S. alone total \$8 billion. In addition to every child getting a vision and hearing check in school on a regular basis, Dr. Fried, an Israeli plastic surgeon, believes an annual skin check is necessary as well, starting in the teens. As a result, Dr. Fried agreed to be the medical consultant for Emerald Medical Applications' DermaCompare, a free smartphone app that uses image processing and predictive analytics to detect changes in marks and moles over time. The app alerts the user of changes that ought to be screened for cancer.
