****ALAN COOPERMAN COMES TO HAR ZION TEMPLE – WEDNESDAY, JULY 13, 7:30 PM
*What Divides Us? What Unites Us? Israel and American Jews***

Alan Cooperman is Director of Religion Research at the Pew Research Center. He is an expert on religion's role in U.S. politics and has reported on religion in Russia, the Middle East and Europe. He plays a central role in planning the project's research agenda and writing its reports. Before joining the Pew Research Center, he was a national reporter and editor at the Washington Post, foreign editor of U.S. News & World Report, and a foreign correspondent for the Associated Press. He graduated magna cum laude from Harvard in 1982 and started in journalism at the Berkshire Eagle in Pittsfield, Mass. He is an author of *Mormons in America*, *Muslim Americans*, the *U.S. Religious Knowledge Survey*, *"Nones" on the Rise* and *A Portrait of Jewish Americans*. He also was

the primary editor of the 2014 U.S. Religious Landscape Study and The Future of World Religions. He has appeared on numerous media outlets, including NPR, BBC, Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, the NewsHour, NBC, ABC, CBS, CNN, Fox, MSNBC and C-SPAN.

The Vi technology resides in cutting-edge Harman/Kardon earphones and provides real-time coaching based on the user's own physiology. "The future of wearables is using AI to personalize our health and fitness in real time, and we created Vi to lead this new frontier," said the CEO and cofounder of LifeBEAM.

Vi contains aerospace-grade biosensors to measure heart rate, heart rate variability, motion, elevation and other parameters; hi-fi sound quality; an ergonomic design; and the ability to learn and grow with each user "By improving a person's awareness of their own behaviors, environment, and real-time physiology, Vi provides an inspiring and truly smarter workout experience. We call Vi an 'Awareable,' as it's the first and only wearable with the power to actually be aware of a person's activity patterns and coach their behavior in real time."
