Technology that can print a human organ – is it science fiction? Israel's Nano Dimension, which makes 3D printers, has taken the first step towards turning big-screen fantasy into everyday reality. Through a collaboration with another Israeli company, biotechnology firm Accellta, Nano Dimension has been able to mix human stem cells into its 3D printer ink. When expelled through the more than 1,000 tiny nozzles of a Nano Dimension DragonFly 3D printer, the ink can form into human tissue. The technology is still at the proof-of-concept stage and going from simple tissue to a full organ is a daunting and uncharted process. Nevertheless, the possibilities for saving lives by "printing" a new liver or lung are amazing.


