## **Talmud with Rabbi Sarra Lev, PhD – Mondays, August 12, 19 and 26, 11:15 AM**

The rabbinic prohibitions against shaming another often lie in stark contrast to stories of shaming and competition among those very same rabbis. The course asks the overarching question – what is the Talmud trying to tell us about shame/shaming?

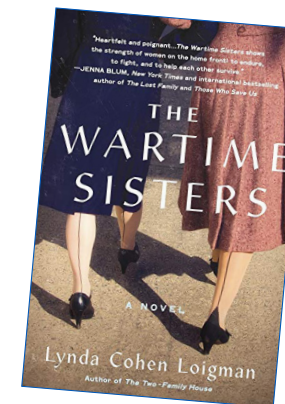
