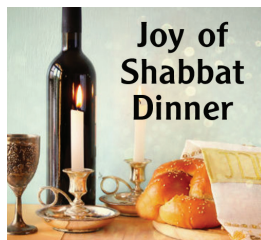

INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Drug for Crohn's Disease Shows Positive Trial Results

RedHill Biopharma Ltd. said that a late stage clinical trial of its drug to treat Crohn's disease found the medication to have positive safety and efficacy results. In a statement, the biopharmaceutical firm said that the results "demonstrated superiority of RHB-104 over a placebo in achieving remission at week 26." The company has developed RB-104 to treat Crohn's, a severe inflammatory affliction of the gastrointestinal tract that has no known cure. As of 2017, some 1.5 million people worldwide had been diagnosed with Crohn's disease, and global sales therapies for this affliction are estimated to exceed \$10 billion in 2018, the statement said, citing data from GlobalData.
