## **INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS**

### ***In the Race to the Moon, SpaceIL Craft Is Approaching the Final Stages***

Israel's non-profit SpaceIL, one of only five teams remaining in the multi-million-dollar Google Lunar XPrize race to the moon, is starting to assemble the craft to be launched in 2018, according to SpaceIL CEO Eran Privman. "We are thrilled to share with you that the various parts and components of the spacecraft are in advanced stages of manufacture in Israel and abroad," he announced this week.

The competition began 10 years ago with 33 teams vying to be the first to soft-land a privately funded, unmanned robot on the moon, move it 500 meters across the moon's surface and transmit high-definition video and photos back to Earth. The top prize is \$20 million. The nonprofit SpaceIL was the last to register, at the end of 2010, but was the first to secure the required launch contract.
