## **INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Revolutionary Patch Keeps Brain Safe after Cranial Surgery**

If you're ever unfortunate enough to require brain surgery, Israeli startup Nurami Medical has got you covered – literally. The Haifa-based company has developed a patch made of synthetic, biodegradable nanofibers meant to be affixed to the dura mater – the protective membrane underneath the skull that keeps the brain and spinal cord safe – after cranial neurosurgery. Brain surgery requires cutting through the dura, so a "bandage" of some sort must be placed to protect against bacteria, accelerate healing and keep cerebral spinal fluid from leaking. Nurami's nanofiber patches mimic the dura mater in a way that's safer and less expensive than the animal collagen-based products currently used for post-brain surgery recovery, said the company's CEO Hanno Marksheid.
