The Revolution That's about to Transform Blood Testing

The way blood-cell counts and diagnostic blood tests are done hasn't changed in years: Your blood gets drawn into one vial for each type of test and sent to a lab, where technicians prepare slides from each sample and examine them under a microscope. Results arrive in hours or days – and then only if you're in a place with the necessary infrastructure. Three Israeli startups aim to revolutionize and democratize how blood tests are done.
