New Israeli device helps correct your posture

In a world where many of us slouch over our keyboards for hours each day, causing all types of back pains – the new Israeli device UpRight can train you to achieve better posture.

The UpRight wearable training device, embedded with dual sensors, attaches to your lower back with hypoallergenic adhesive strips and gently vibrates every time you slouch. The UpRight company claims that wearing the device less than an hour a day will train your muscles and mind to sit and stand upright after only two or three weeks of use.

An optional companion mobile app for Android and iOS generates a customized training program offering real-time feedback, posture analytics, statistics, tips and techniques.
