INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS

Hope Draws Near For Bone Marrow Patients

The excitement at Jerusalem-based Gamida Cell, a maker of cell and immune therapy technologies, is palpable. The biotechnology company has started enrolling patients for a last-stage clinical trial for a drug it believes will help increase the success of bone marrow transplants in blood cancer patients, and help them better withstand the ordeal of the lifesaving procedure. NiCord, which would be the first drug developed by Gamida to hit the market, if the trial goes well, is believed to increase the chances of a successful bone marrow transplantation process for patients who do not have a rapidly available, fully matched, bone marrow donor. Today some high-risk blood cancers cannot be cured unless patients undergo a bone marrow graft. For that purpose, 100-percent match needs to be found, a process that in the US, takes an average of three to four months if the patient is lucky. Sometimes, no match is found. "There are 70,000 patients a year globally with blood cancers who need a bone marrow transplant," Gamida Cell's CEO Yael Margolin said. "It is a rare condition. But for that transplant, you need a donor with full tissue matching. As many as 50% don't get to the transplant phase, because they haven't found a matching donor in time."
