INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS

Multiple Diseases Can Be Detected With a Single Blood Test

An Israeli-led international team of researchers has proof of concept for a single blood test that can detect multiple conditions in a highly sensitive and specific manner, including diabetes, cancer, traumatic injury and neurodegeneration. The novel method zeroes in on patterns of circulating DNA that is released by dying cells and traces it to specific types of tissue. The study was reported in a paper in the journal Proceedings of National Academy of Sciences USA. Cell death can signify the early stages of pathology (such as a developing tumor or the beginning of an autoimmune or neurodegenerative disease), mark disease progression, reflect the success of therapy (such as anti-cancer drugs), and identify unintended toxic effects of treatment and more.
